**Re: Class Action for Girls' Homes and Boys' Homes
Whitbourne, Pleasantville, Torbay, and City of St. John's**

We are writing to advise you of a development with the Class Action in relation to the above-noted matter. The Court has ordered the following changes to the Settlement Approval Order:

- (1) appointing "Morris Moore" as Class Counsel in place of "Morris Martin Moore", as our law firm has recently had a name change;
- (2) extending the Claims Period to **February 9, 2024**, as opposed to the previous date of October 9, 2023; and
- (3) approving the Track 1 A Claim Form (Estates) for deceased claimants who have died since March 10, 2022, and whose claims are being continued by their estate.

While the Claims Period ends February 9, 2024, there is a 30-day period for appeals. The appeal period will end March 11, 2024. It is not possible for money to be distributed before that date. Once the appeal period ends, the claims must be assessed, and a report must be filed with the Court to ensure that everything is done as set out in the Order. We are hopeful that money will flow shortly thereafter.

The extension of the Claims Period is disappointing, but unfortunately, delays are a part of every case. We know you have been very patient, and we thank you for your continued support. **If you have already submitted your Claim Form, you do not have to do anything.** If you have not yet submitted your Claim Form, please ensure that you have submitted this on or before the deadline of **February 9, 2024**.
